Administrator Jones addressed the Commission regarding the purchase of dumpsters for the Public Works Department. Discussion held.

Commissioner Truelove moved to approve the purchase of dumpsters from Armor Equipment in an amount not to exceed \$10,200. Seconded by Mayor Johnson. Motion carried.

Administrator Jones addressed the Commission regarding the 2026 4th of July Fireworks Agreement with Aerial FX Inc and Miller Pyrotechnics. Discussion held.

Commissioner Truelove moved to approve the purchase of fireworks from Aerial FX Inc in an amount not to exceed \$10,500. Seconded by Mayor Johnson. Motion carried.

Mayor Johnson moved to approve the shooting fee for the 4th of July show to Miller Pyrotechnics in an amount not to exceed \$1,585. Seconded by Commissioner Truelove. Motion carried.
