

RECYCLING PROGRAM

WHAT: Items must be separated and sorted by type, rinsed out with lids removed, and securely bagged.

- Newspapers, magazines, office paperwork, junk mail, catalogs, shredded paper, books and phone books. (All need to be kept dry and bagged.)

- Cardboard
 - Plastic
- 

(Please rinse and remove lids.)

- Aluminum cans. (Flatten if possible.)
- Steel cans. (Any cans that are magnetic. Please rinse and remove labels.)
- Glass. (Bottles and jars only.)
- Car, household and lawn mower Batteries.
- E-Waste: Computers, scanners, DVD Players or VCR, Vacuum Cleaners, copiers, TV's ink toner cartridges, telephones and cell phones.

DO NOT RECYCLE:

Plastic Bags, tires, wax cardboard, light bulbs, windshields, mirrors, pottery, paint & aerosol cans, hazardous & building materials, light bulbs, Styrofoam, packing peanuts, bubble wrap, napkins, paper towels, diapers, Kleenexes, paper plates, tissue paper, wrapping paper, tin foil, pie pans and any cans that aren't magnetic, and candy wrappers.

WHEN: South of Main: 1st Thursday of the month.

North of Main to Fir: 2nd Thursday.

North of Fir & East of 4th St.: 3rd Thursday

WHERE: Curbside or take to the City recyclable trailer located at the City Shop, 1200 W. Granby.
